
The Montgomery Family

All active members of the youth group are invited to a lock in.


Saving Grace

Looking Forward in Worship Matthew 2:1-11, 16-18

The Point: Jesus is Lord and He deserves our worship.

The Bible Meets Life: Most churches try their best to offer convenience when it comes to worship. That's not a bad thing. We need to try to remove any obstacles believers might have to be able to worship. We have climate-controlled spaces, preferred parking for seniors, visitors, and expectant mothers. Coffee is often available in the foyer, and since the pandemic, many churches offer a streaming option, so people can join in from the comfort of their own couch or even bed. It's easy to forget that there are people half a world away who risk their lives to worship with other believers. For them it takes planning and a little cunning to be at church. Some don't enjoy access to Bibles. They pass around scraps of Bibles they salvaged from the last confiscation they experienced in the village by authorities.

We might worship in comfort, ease, and convenience, but we are a slim minority of the long history of the worshiping church, including the wise men who made the arduous journey to kneel at the feet of the Christ child.

Live It Out: Pray. We can't escape the tyranny and suffering of the world. We read it in our news feeds and see it on the Internet. Our world is broken. Spend time this week praying for those who are suffering under the rule of tyrants. Prioritize. As the new year approaches, spend some time prioritizing how you will spend your time and money, so that you can best worship God in every area of your life. Act. Begin a gospel conversation with a person who is far from God. Ask if you can tell your story of how Jesus changed your life and why you worship Him as Savior.
