
ission God has placed upon hi heart in our little corner of Monroe and beyond. We welcome all comments and

The Inspiration for Worship Psalm 25:4-15

The Point: God's goodness and love lead us to worship Him.

The Bible Meets Life: We've all seen it a thousand times watching football games. A player makes a phenomenal play and returns to the sideline. He's engulfed by his teammates and coaches. As the celebration winds down, the player recognizes a television camera is on him and almost every time, he looks at the camera and says, "Hi, Mom!"

It doesn't matter that dad taught him everything he knows about football. In the moment when the world is watching, mom is the one who gets the greeting. Why?

It's natural to respond to the nurturing we get from our mothers. Sure, dad helped us become something, but mom made us want to be something by making us feel cared for and loved.

But even our mothers don't care for us like God does. When we remember God's compassion and faithfulness that goes back to the beginning of time, we want to let the world know about His love. And when everyone is looking at us, we want to be seen worshiping.

Live It Out: The Starting Place. We are inspired to worship when we consider the love and forgiveness God has shown us in Christ. What are some of the ways God inspired your worship this week? Make a list and thank Him for each one. The Growing Place. We also respond in worship to His leadership in our lives, as He lovingly guides and directs our paths. How did God lead you this past week?
