

Sunday, December 22 2024

Looking Forward to Love John 1:14-18; 3:14-18

<u>The Point</u>: We can know the love of God because of Jesus's sacrifice.

<u>The Bible Meets Life</u>: "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us" (John 1:14). This is the essence of Advent and Christmas. God came to us. Jesus is God with skin on. The theological word for that is *incarnation* or *enfleshment*.

Luke provided a detailed, orderly account of Jesus birth, but John begins his testament revealing the backstory and the nature of the incarnation. John 1 is a dense, poetic, and powerful prologue where the essence of the story is revealed. The centerpiece is the powerful declaration that Jesus is God with skin on. He chose to step into flesh because of love. Any way you slice it, this story has always been a love story.

Live It Out: Read. Set aside a block of time to read 1 John in one sitting. It will take you about fifteen to twenty minutes to do it but take your time and meditate on it. Read it with fresh eyes. Mark a verse or two that grab your attention. Meditate on this book of love through this busy season. Step into the story. Want to kick it up a notch? Make a short list of the people around you who need love the most this Christmas. Select one person from the list and find a way to share the love of Jesus in a tangible way. Pray. Be intentional to make time for the people who need love the most this Christmas. Pray for them regularly. Ask God to reveal His great love with power and clarity.
