

#### The 7 Signs of John

"Truly Jesus did many other signs and miracles in the presence of His disciples which are not written in this book; but these were written that you may fully believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that in the act of believing, you may have life in His name." (John 20:30-31)

The first twelve chapters of John are called the Book of Signs. God's revelation through John is very clear as to why He focuses so heavily on these seven miracles. These signs are vivid proof of Jesus' status as the Christ, the Messiah, and that these miracles purposefully point readers to faith in Jesus as Lord and Savior.

The seven pivotal signs, when Jesus "manifested His glory" (John 2:11), in the Gospel of John are:

- 1. The sign of His Glory Changing water into wine (John 2)
- 2. The sign of His Grace Healing the royal official's son (John 4:46-54)
- 3. The sign of His Authority Healing the man at the pool of Bethesda (John 5:1-11)
- 4. The sign of His Provision The feeding of the 5,000 (John 6:1-15)
- 5. The sign of His Presence Walking on the water (John 6:16-21)
- 6. The sign of His Light Healing the man born blind (John 9:1-12)
- 7. The sign of His Power Over Death Resurrecting Lazarus (John 11)

**Seven.** Seven is an important number for John, as for all Judaism. It symbolizes perfection, completion, fulfillment, and wholeness. John's use of seven is seen in his seven signs, the seven I AM's, the seven major discourses, and the seven life-changing conversations in the gospel. Seven also implies the seven days of creation and when creation was completed and found to be good. Jesus, now, continues the work that God began in Genesis.

**Wine.** Jesus changed the water into wine at the wedding in Cana. In performing this miracle, Jesus continued creation by taking simple water and rearranging its atomic elements, developing a whole new substance. Jesus revealed a God who is not simply a maintainer of what is, but a creator of what was not.

**Nature.** Jesus proved there were no earthly limits to His heavenly powers. He could instantly create aged wine, He could walk on water, He could heal from a distance, He could multiply foods. Why, Jesus could do the two things that were deemed impossible in that era: give sight to the blind, and raise a dead person to life. As the Son of God, Jesus could operate within the created world or outside of it, depending on what He wanted to accomplish. The signs of Christ, according to John, proved that Jesus was what He said He was; Messiah, Son of the Father, Co-creator, and Sustainer.

**Proof.** What did Jesus point to as proof of His Messiahship? "John's two disciples found Jesus and said to him, 'John the Baptist sent us to ask. Are you the Messiah we've been expecting, or should we keep looking for someone else?' At that very time, Jesus cured many people of their diseases, illnesses, and evil spirits, and he restored sight to many who were blind. Then he told John's disciples, 'Go back to John and tell him what you have seen and heard – the blind see, the lame walk, those with leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised to life, and the Good News is being preached to the poor." (Luke 7:20-22). The people need look no further, says Jesus, and neither should you, John. These miracles point to who I really am. These are the signs of my divinity, says Jesus.

#### **Saving Grace**



All help will be confidential.




## Haley's Ministry Prayer Requests & Praises



# Bible Studies For Life Summary All Signs Point to Jesus

Recently our family went on vacation. We were excited about the opportunity to go to a local tubing company and float down the river. On the way to the launch, we came across a sign that read: "Bridge Out." While we had never been down this road before, the directions on the GPS were telling us with clarity to continue down the path. So, we continued, while keeping in the back of our minds what the sign had just shown us. Soon, however, we reached the point where we could go no further. The sign had been true! It turns out the GPS hadn't updated to show that the bridge was out. We could see the launch point across the river, but we had to get back in the car and find another way to get there.



Signs are important. Over the next several sessions, we're going to explore eight signs that point to the truth of who Jesus is. Our hope is that you will see how the evidence is clear that Jesus is the Son of God, so that you can grow in your trust of Him. Whether you're a seeker of truth, a new believer, or a seasoned follower of Christ, this study in the Gospel of John will point you in the right direction to the person, nature, power, and identity of Jesus Christ.


#### **New Sunday School Class**
