




Christmas Cards

Looking Forward to Joy Luke 2:4-14

The Point: Jesus has come, giving us much cause for joy.

The Bible Meets Life: Billy Bray was a poor miner from across the pond in Cornwall, England. He became a Christ-follower at the age of 29 in the 1800s, after years of drunkenness and wild living. He became such a figure of joy, Billy was called, "God's glad man." Billy's life personified boundless joy, which often presented itself in some peculiar ways. Whether he was mining or preaching, people said he would often spontaneously dance, shout, and jump. Sounds weird to our conservative sensibilities, doesn't it? He was saved radically, and he celebrated it radically for over forty years from the time of his conversion until his death. The source of his joy was Jesus and only Jesus. As we walk through Advent together, we encounter joy at every turn. If we consider the great gift of salvation and don't react with great joy, we'd have to ask ourselves, "Who's the odd person—Billy Bray or us?"

Live It Out: Reflect. Spend a moment reflecting on the time you received God's gift of salvation. If you haven't received salvation, you'll never have a better time than now. Celebrate. If you want to experience a simple taste of joy, celebrate someone. Write a note, give a gift, and share a story with someone you know. In so doing, you'll bring joy through an encouraging act of kindness. Give. Second Corinthians 9:7 reminds us that God loves a cheerful giver. So many research studies claim that the most joyful people on earth are the givers. This year, make plans to give more then you've ever given to missions work.
